71% of pupils achieved a 4+ in Maths and 75% of pupils achieved a 4+ in their best English.

63% of pupils achieved a 4+ in both English and Maths.

48% of pupils achieved a 4+ in two Sciences.

46% of pupils achieved a 4+ in History or Geography

58% of pupils achieved a 4+ in a Modern Foreign Language.

Our Attainment 8 figure was 43.2.
