

Information About School Uniform

A high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students and anyone arriving at school in non-uniform clothing may expect to be sent home to get changed.

- Make-up is not permitted at school.
- Jewellery is not permitted at school.
- Outdoor coats must not be worn in the building.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- Mobile telephones must not be used in school.
- Personal electronic equipment must not be used in school.

Equipment

Every student is expected to bring the following basic items of equipment to every lesson:

Mathematics - Calculator, protractor, angle measurer, set square, compasses.

| Socks | - | Plain grey or black ONLY. |
| Shoes | - | Plain, black, SCHOOL STYLE. No fashion footwear such as boots, platforms or buckles.
No suede, nubuck or canvas material. |
| Scarf | - | School scarf or plain, NAVY or BLACK. |

Caps/Hats - Plain woollen hats (small motifs acceptable) only when weather is unsuitable. All other types of hats are NOT allowed.

NB: Trainers are NOT ALLOWED except for P.E. lessons and when playing sports at break times.

Students should be able to polish shoes.

White plimsolls or training shoes (non marking) NO BASKETBALL BOOTS.

A clean 'named sock' or valuables bag (available from Hewitts) for watch, money etc.

JEWELLERY

No jewellery is to be worn at school.

FACIAL HAIR – Faces should be clean-shaven.

HAIR

Hair style at school should be approached as uniform. The style should be appropriate, presentable and safe at school. Hair must be above collar length and curly hair/afro-style hair must not be excessively long. Straight cane rows are acceptable. Shorter styles should not be cut closer than grade 2 anywhere and must be of an even cut all over the head. There should be no tracks, tramlines, steps or other fancy cuts. Centre parting styles should be such that hair does not fall over the eyes and face; eyebrow length is a good guide.

Treatments such as sprays and gels MUST NOT be applied. Hair colourings must not be applied.

BAG

Each student must have a bag which is suitable to carry school books and other items needed for school (eg P.E. kit). The bag should keep water out and the style of bag should ensure that school books are kept in good condition. P.E. kit should be suitably separated from books if

carried in the same bag. The size of bag should not be excessive; very large sports holdalls are not acceptable in school.

ALL property, uniform, P.E. kit, equipment etc. **MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED** with the owner's name.

This list and the school's policy indicates that **SCHOOL STYLES** should be worn. Fashion clothes are not permitted. **PLEASE CHECK** with the School if in doubt.

NB: FOR SAFETY REASONS, AEROSOL DEODORANTS AND ANY OTHER AEROSOL SPRAYS ARE NOT ALLOWED

Top coat/raincoat Plain, **ALL NAVY BLUE** or **BLACK** cloth without logos

Blazer

YEARS 7-10 - Bottle Green **WITH** badge.

YEAR 11 - Black or Bottle Green **WITH** badge.

Skirt/Trousers

Medium grey **SCHOOL STYLE** - 4 gore 'A' line with a single box pleat at the front or a pleated skirt with a fixed waist band or an elasticated waist band – knee to mid-calf length.

	Skirts with splits ARE NOT ALLOWED and neither are button through fastenings.
	Black SCHOOL STYLE trousers may also be worn, Trousers must be of <u>non</u> -stretch material.
Shirt	White school shirt with tie.
Vest	Vests worn under blouses/shirts must be white only WITHOUT motifs or added colour.
Pullover	YEARS 7-10 - Bottle Green V neck, SCHOOL

Tie	School tie. Obtainable from C. Hewitt & Son Limited.
Socks/Tights	Plain white socks or plain black tights.
Shoes	Plain black, SCHOOL STYLE, low heel. No fashion footwear such as slingbacks, platform shoes or boots. No suede, nubuck, patent or canvas material. No fancy buckles or accessories.
Scarf	School scarf or plain, self-coloured NAVY or BLACK.
Caps/Hats	Plain woollen hats, (small motif acceptable) only when weather is unsuitable. All other types of hats are NOT allowed.

NB: Trainers are NOT ALLOWED except for P.E. lessons and when playing sports at break times.
Students should be able to polish shoes.

GIRLS' PE KIT:

Bottle Green wrap over skirt - Years 7 and 8
 Black Umbro style shorts
 Bottle Green sweatshirt
 Plain black tracksuit bottoms
 Plain white short sleeved polo shirt (no logos)
 White socks
 Black swimming costume, one piece Swimming cap (optional)
 Towel for swimming
 White plimsolls or training shoes (non marking) **NO BASKETBALL BOOTS**
 A clean 'named sock' or valuables bag (available from Hewitts) for watch, money etc.

JEWELLERY:

No jewellery is to be worn at school.

MAKE-UP:

No make-up is to be worn at school or nail extensions to be worn at school.

HAIR:

Hair style at school should be approached as uniform. The style should be appropriate, presentable and safe at school. Fancy adornments, including coloured hair extensions, should not be worn and treatments such as sprays and gels **MUST NOT** be applied. Hair should not fall over the eyes and face and long hair **MUST** be tied back. Hair colourings must not be applied. Hair bands may be black, brown or green – **NO OTHER COLOURS.**

SCHOOL BAG:

Each student must have a bag which is suitable to carry school books and other items needed for school (eg P.E. kit). The bag should keep water out and the style of bag should ensure that school books are kept in good condition. P.E. kit should be suitably separated from books if carried in the same bag.

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
