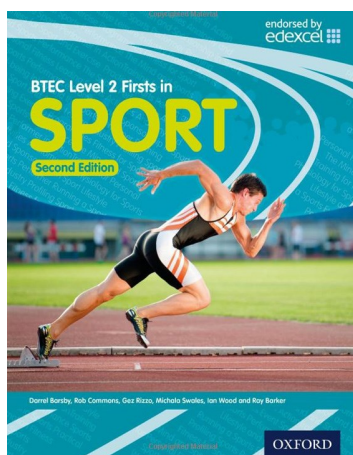

Students will be assessed in three internally assessed units that are coursework based.

The subject teacher marks each, internally assessed, unit to PASS, MERIT or DISTINCTION standard. The overall grade is allocated based on how well each unit is completed

The fourth unit is a 1 hour computerised test that is marked externally.

Topics covered across the course include; Practical Sport, Psychology of



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It is expected that all students are **punctual** to lesson and have full equipment - this includes PE kit for practical sessions. **Coursework** must be completed on time.

Parents can support learning by ensuring that all deadlines for coursework are met. **Check planner** regularly for updates on coursework deadlines.

Print the checklists for each assignment and go through the coursework to ensure all key topics are covered
